

2008 Highlights & Accomplishments

- ◆ **Integrated Behavioral Health Services** began provision of mental health services for patients being seen in CommuniCare's primary care clinics. These services are designed to address the multidimensional psychosocial needs of our client population as a part of the continuum of primary care services.
- ◆ **The 2008 Migrant Health Center Outstanding Service Award**, a prestigious national recognition, was presented to CommuniCare by the National Association of Community Health Centers at the annual National Farmworker Health Conference. CommuniCare was honored for an outstanding level of excellence in the migrant health care field and a high level of commitment and innovation in service to migrant farm workers and their families.
- ◆ **The Lorraine Lunden Scholarship Fund**—CommuniCare Health Centers established the Lorraine Lunden Scholarship Fund to assist CommuniCare staff members in furthering their professional development through education in a health-related discipline. Named in honor of Lorraine Lunden, a Physician Assistant at CommuniCare who has been with the organization for over thirty years, the annual scholarship is funded through staff donations and community fund raising.
- ◆ **Mother Baby Friendly Workplace Award for Yolo County**—The Community Breastfeeding Coalition of Yolo County recognized CommuniCare for excellence in providing support for mothers at work by creating a baby friendly work environment and thereby improving the health of mothers and babies.

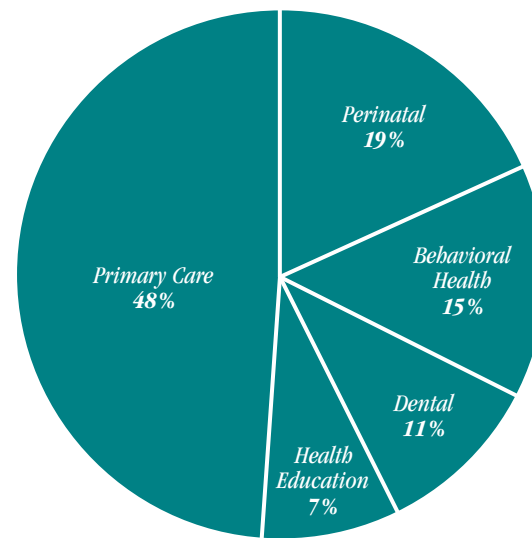

Staff Profile

In addition to paid staff, 235 volunteers donated their time in 2008 to provide services to CommuniCare's clients. Among our valued volunteers were 37 physicians, 8 dentists, 2 optometrists, 1 psychologist, 1 pharmacist, 5 medical students, 10 mid-level practitioner students, 7 counselor interns, 35 dental interns, 6 nursing students and 123 community members who filled such positions as patient assistants, translators, lab assistants, teen reproductive health educators, social worker assistants, and child development assistants. Volunteers are essential to the organization and contribute to the quality of care and the cost effectiveness of the operations of the clinics.

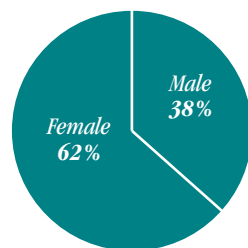

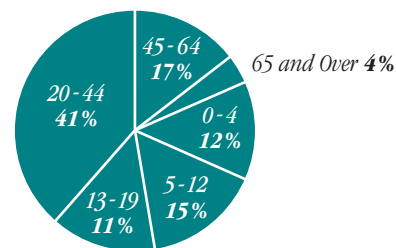

17% 101 to 200% of the Poverty Level

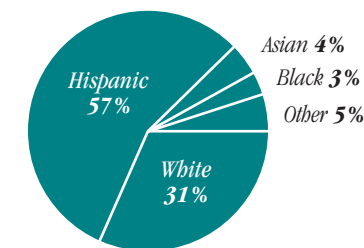
