

## 2009 Highlights & Accomplishments

- ◆ **The Sierra Sacramento Valley Medical Society 2009 Community Service Award**—The Sierra Sacramento Valley Medical Society presented CommuniCare Health Centers with the Society's 2009 Medical Community Award, recognizing CommuniCare's valued medical service to the community. The Medical Community Award is presented annually to a community organization or community leader in El Dorado, Sacramento or Yolo County deserving of high recognition for their significant contribution in addressing a medical or public health problem.
- ◆ **Dental Wing Renovation at Davis Community Clinic**—Renovation of the Dental Wing at Davis Community Clinic created a fourth dental operatory in an area that was previously used as office space, resulting in increased capacity for access to dental care. The project was funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009, as part of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Capital Improvement Program for health centers.
- ◆ **Woodland Community College**—CommuniCare began providing primary care services on the campus of Woodland Community College this year. The clinic offers student health services while classes are in session. The services are provided free of charge to students enrolled at the college.
- ◆ **Lutheran Medical Center Dental Residency**—CommuniCare began an affiliation with the Lutheran Medical Center (LMC) of Brooklyn, New York, to host a general dentistry resident through LMC's Advanced Education in General Dentistry Residency Program. The dental resident works full time providing comprehensive dental services to patients in CommuniCare's Dental Program.
- ◆ **Nutrition Program**—In partnership with the Central Valley Health Network, CommuniCare began a Nutrition Program to provide nutrition education and promote physical activity to low-income families living in Yolo County. The program also promotes the USDA's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (federal food stamp program). The Nutrition Program offers individual and group education within our clinics, at health fairs, and through outreach in the community with the goal of reducing morbidity and mortality related to chronic diseases, including obesity, through good nutrition and physical activity.

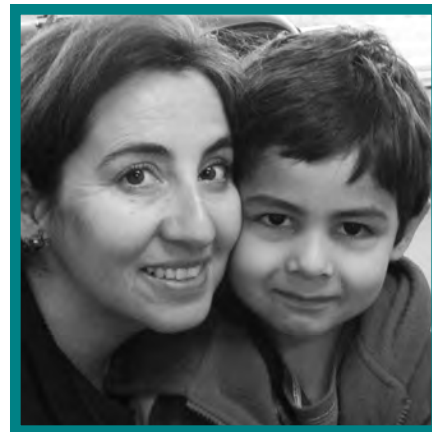

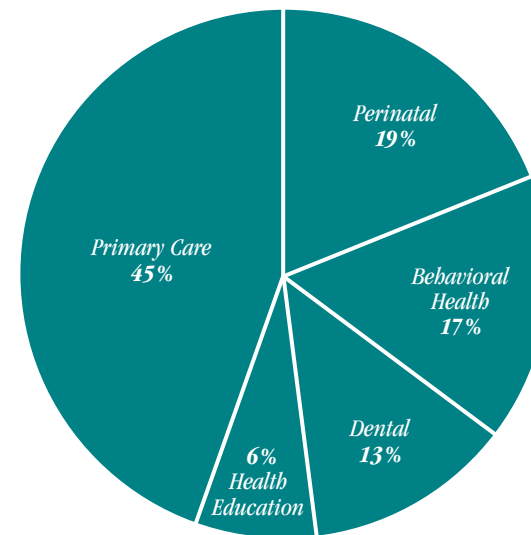

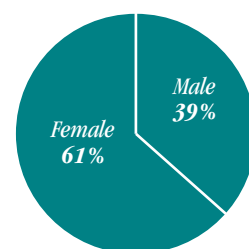

#### Volunteers

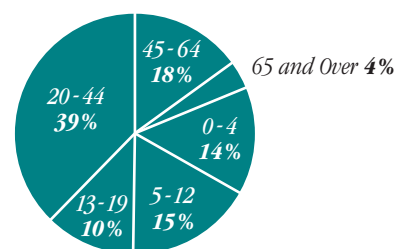

Among our valued volunteers were 50 physicians, 9 dentists, 1 pharmacist, 11 family practice residents, 1 dental resident, 6 medical students, 6 mid-level practitioner students, 10 counselor interns, 51 dental interns, 7 nursing students, 1 midwife student, and 56 community members who filled such positions as patient assistants, translators, lab assistants, teen reproductive health educators, social worker assistants, and child development assistants.

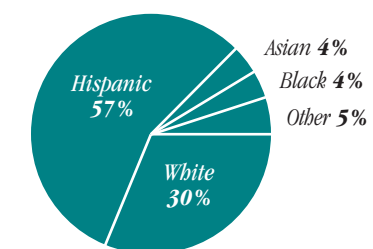
